OUR PROGRAMMES

OUR APPROACH

- **Face to face workshops** – delivered in your school/setting by expert trainers for maximum impact
- **Max 1:30 trainer to student ratio** – delivering personalised learning and resultant high progress with one trainer per workshop
- **Full year cohort on one day** – we can deliver multiple workshops at the same time by providing one trainer per class or group. We also work with more targeted groups
- **Progressive workshops, whole school approach** - with a range of workshops, we can return to work with students to further develop skills and provide progressive, longer term oracy impact
