### Key Impact Measures

Our trainers ask your students to rate to what extent they agree or disagree with each of 4 standardised Impact Statements. - Statement A** *I am more excited about trying new opportunities at secondary school*
- Statement B** *I feel more confident about overcoming any challenges I might face at secondary school*
- Statement C** *I feel happier to speak to people I do not know well*
- Statement D** *This workshop has given me more confidence to keep trying even if at first, I don't succeed*

### Impact Statements - Summary of responses

**84 %** of students agreed or strongly agreed that they felt more excited about trying new opportunities at secondary school after the workshop

**85 %** of students agreed or strongly agreed that they felt more confident about overcoming any challenges they might face at secondary school after the workshop

**72 %** of students agreed or strongly agreed that they felt happier to speak to people they do not know well after the workshop

**70 %** of students agreed or strongly agreed that the workshop gave them more confidence to keep trying, even if at first, they don't succeed


