

Environmental and Sustainability Policy

Purpose

This policy sets out Talk The Talk's commitment to environmental responsibility and sustainable practices. As a UK charity, we recognise our duty to minimise our environmental impact, comply with relevant legislation, and act as a role model for sustainability within the voluntary sector.

Scope

This policy applies to:

- Trustees, staff, volunteers, and contractors
- All charity operations, including fundraising, events, procurement, and service delivery
- · Partnerships and collaborations where our charity has influence

Principles

We are guided by the following principles:

- Compliance: Adhering to UK environmental legislation and Charity Commission guidance.
- Prevention: Reducing waste, emissions, and resource use wherever possible.
- Continuous Improvement: Reviewing and improving our practices regularly.
- Transparency: Reporting openly on our environmental performance.
- Leadership: Encouraging sustainable behaviours among our stakeholders.

Commitments

Energy and Carbon

- Reduce energy consumption in offices and venues.
- Prioritise renewable energy suppliers where feasible.
- Monitor and aim to reduce our carbon footprint annually.

Waste and Recycling

- · Minimise single-use plastics and unnecessary packaging.
- Provide recycling facilities at all charity premises and events.
- Reuse materials and equipment wherever possible.

Travel and Transport

- Encourage sustainable travel (public transport, cycling, walking).
- Reduce reliance on car travel and flights.
- Promote remote meetings to cut down unnecessary travel.

Procurement and Suppliers

- Source goods and services from ethical, sustainable suppliers.
- Consider environmental impact in all purchasing decisions.
- Work with partners who share our sustainability values.



Events and Fundraising

- Plan events to minimise environmental impact (digital options, sustainable venues).
- Use environmentally friendly materials in fundraising campaigns.
- Encourage supporters to adopt sustainable practices.

Roles and Responsibilities

- **Trustees:** Ensure environmental considerations are embedded in governance and decision-making.
- Staff and Volunteers: Implement sustainable practices in daily activities.
- Suppliers and Partners: Align with our sustainability standards.

Monitoring and Reporting

- Annual review of environmental performance by trustees.
- Publish a sustainability statement in our annual report.
- Set measurable targets (e.g., % reduction in energy use, % recycled waste).
